4. Do you support or oppose allowing state-licensed medical cannabis facilities in your district?
5. Do you support or oppose allowing state-licensed recreational cannabis facilities in your district?
6. Do you support or oppose adding social equity reforms to Michigan's existing laws that would ensure people of color, women and those harmed disproportionately by cannabis prohibition are able to enter into and obtain state licenses in the legal cannabis industry?
